Stabling

- 12x12 outdoor paneled stalls included
- Bring pellet bedding (or purchase on site)
- Bring water buckets. A water hose will reach to all stalls
- Stalls to be mucked by owners but an ATV with wagon or a wheel barrow is available.

Accommodations

- Outdoor camping by tent in field where stalls are located
- RV's welcome but no hook ups or electricity. Water is available for refill
- Hotels in Cle Elum approximately 15 minutes away. Email for suggestions.

Meals Included

- 3 breakfasts
- 3 lunches
- 2 dinners

The meals are professionally catered. Bottled water and drinks will be available. We will have some wine, beer and basic stuff for mixers. If you like something special, please bring it.

Arrival

Arrive the afternoon before camp starts or early the 1st morning to get settled in, go for a hack, relax and get ready for camp! Lessons start the 1st morning at 9am prompt and camp will end by 3pm or earlier on the last day.
